2- BRAKING SYSTEM

0 - SCOPE

The provisions set out below shall apply to the draw and buffing gear and to the braking system to be used on internal combustion-engined railcars and multiple unit sets to enable them to be hauled, in an emergency, by any tractive unit.

1 - DRAW AND BUFFING GEAR

- 1.1 At each end likely to be coupled to the assisting unit, the stock shall be provided;
- either with draw and buffing gear complying with the regulations of the UIC Code,
- or with automatic couplers (central buffer couplers).
- 1.2 Vehicles equipped with automatic couplers must have a mixed coupler allowing them to be coupled to the assisting unit fitted with draw gear in accordance with Leaflet 520.

The mixed coupler must make it possible :

- to continue the haulage of the vehicles at a speed of at least 100 km/h,
- and to propel the set at low speeds.

2 - BRAKING SYSTEM

The braking system must allow the railcar or set to be hauled at a speed of at least 100 km/h in an emergency, by a tractive unit fitted with the UIC single-pipe passenger brake.
