Note The installation note below applies to Version 1.3.1, as it has to the installation of the Datafeed Toolbox since Version 1.2.

FT Interactive Data Server

The default location for installing FT Interactive Data client software is
C:\RPLUS.

For successful operation after installation, add this directory to the Microsoft Windows system path:

- For Windows 98, enter this directory in the autoexec.bat file.
- For Windows NT, use the **System** Control Panel to add this directory to the path.

The Datafeed Toolbox Version 1.3 adds the Hyperfeed data server to the list of previously supported servers (i.e., Bloomberg, FT Interactive Data, and Yahoo). Version 1.3 provides functions to obtain price, profile, historical and tick data from Hyperfeed.

The Datafeed Toolbox effectively turns your MATLAB workstation into a financial data acquisition terminal. Using the Datafeed Toolbox, you can download a wide variety of security data from financial data servers into your MATLAB workspace. Then, you can pass this data to MATLAB or to another toolbox, such as the Financial Time Series Toolbox, for further analysis.
